

## Climate zones in the Klimahaus®

Five climate zones await the visitors at the Klimahaus®. Not only the temperatures mirror those of each original location, but also the humidity and the scents. The polar climate of the Antarctic implies icy cold – in the exhibition area the air will be dry and as cold as  $-6^{\circ}\text{C}$  ( $21^{\circ}\text{F}$ ). The climate in central and western Europe in the summer months is characterised by temperatures of between  $20^{\circ}\text{C}$  and  $26^{\circ}\text{C}$  ( $70^{\circ}\text{F}$  –  $80^{\circ}\text{F}$ ) with a relative humidity of around 50%. Visitors to the Klimahaus® encounter this climate at the stations in Bremerhaven and Switzerland. Temperatures of between  $25^{\circ}\text{C}$  and  $30^{\circ}\text{C}$  ( $78^{\circ}\text{F}$  –  $88^{\circ}\text{F}$ ) and a relative humidity of around 50% attract many holiday-makers to Mediterranean destinations each year – represented in the Klimahaus® by a wild meadow in Sardinia. The area dedicated to Niger has an arid desert climate with temperatures of  $35^{\circ}\text{C}$  ( $98^{\circ}\text{F}$ ). The tropical climate in Cameroun and Samoa is characterised by almost 80% relative humidity with temperatures of  $30^{\circ}\text{C}$  ( $88^{\circ}\text{F}$ ), and is reflected in a lush flora.
